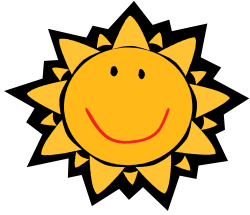


Country Montessori School Elementary Summer Camp 2015

Our Summer Camp themes are:

Week 1, June 22 - June 26: Celebrations Around the World

Join us as we celebrate, commemorate, and enjoy the diversity of people and holidays throughout the world! We'll explore other cultures by participating in a variety of traditional celebrations. We will make decorations and ethnic food to create a festive atmosphere. Listening to traditional music and learning a dance or two will all be part of the fun too.

Weeks 2, June 29 – July 2 (4 days): Become a Rock Star with Mr. Short

Campers will get to live their dreams of being rock and pop stars at this fun-filled music camp. They will learn to sing, dance, and play their favorite hit songs and even write some music of their own. There will be guitars, keyboards, microphones, and DRUMS! Students will even get to record some for their own music and design their own cool musical crafts. Don't miss out on this camp that will have your feet stomping and hands clapping.

Weeks 3, July 6 - 10: Famous Artists

You will stretch your brain and your creativity and have fun as you try to solve problems.

Week 5, July 20 - 24: Folklore, Hero's, and Legends

Have you ever wondered what the difference between myth and legend, folklore and tall tale? Come and find out as we also explore the difference between normal legend and urban legend through the art of storytelling. We will learn about the hero's and legends of American culture, African culture, Native American culture, and Australian culture as we read stories, sing songs, listen to music, learn cultural dances and do lots of fun crafts.

Week 6, July 27 - 31: Ocean Exploration
