Children are to bring their own healthy, balanced lunch in a small soft-sided lunch bag. Cold water is served. Snacks of obvious sugar and/or fat content and low nutritional value will be returned home. Containers need to be opened easily by the child. Refrigeration or heating of food is not available.

On the first day of school, your child should bring a change of clothes to be kept at school. Please bring a swimsuit and towel labeled with the child's name. There will be water play for "cooling off" throughout the summer.

Primary Summer Camp 2015 (Ages 2.5 - Kindergarten)

Our Summer Camp themes are:

Week 1, June 22 - June 26: Music Safari with Mr. Short

Campers will go on a musical adventure around the world. They will have fun learning and singing about animals and cultures from the Australian Outback all the way to the African Savanna. They will enjoy playing musical games and activities, exploring instruments and even making some of their own creations. So come join us on this exciting journey!
